O people in Zion, inhabitant in Jerusalem, you will weep no longer. He will surely be gracious to you at the sound of your cry, when He hears it He will answer you (Isaiah 30:18,19).

The Pulaar are an unreached people group scattered across the western part of West Africa. They are also related to other Fulani ethnic groups across West Africa. We have the clear move to the Spirit to reach out to five villages in the Gambia, near Basse Santa Su. The recon work has been done, the villages chosen, the permission given, the nurses hired, and the formulary given to the pharmacist. Our team is in place and we have proven men from Mali, Guinea, Senegal and now The Gambia, joining together to bring the gospel of the Kingdom to these lost souls who do not want religion. Their hearts long for what we have, the Master’s love.

I have compiled a list of prayer requests for you to consider. Pick one or two and lift them and us up to the Lord:

1. May the Lord open the door for us to operate in love, power

Asad and Mamoud completed successfully their mission to Benin last month and now wish to make a return trip to the Borgou. Muhammad had a dream which occurred twice. In the dream the Lord handed him two sets of silver keys hanging by a wooden key chain. He then proclaimed to him, “go and preach to them my messages.” Simple dream, perhaps not so simple meaning. However, to me it means I need to prioritize his evangelistic activities and send him back to Niger which he has already planned to do at the end of this month. Although I believe I am fully funded for The Gambia, the combination of Asad’s return to Benin, and Muhammad’s return to reach villages in Niger between Zinder and Tanout, will cost \$1,750 and \$3,000 respectively for a total of \$4,750.

You know this mission has never been about me, so by faith we are going to do this. Prince is already funded to go back to Taraba state this month. Fahad was successful among the Bainoa and Fulani in Cameroon (over 1,200 came to Christ). Pastor **Aariz** continues to see fruit among the Nuni in Burkina Faso.
